PGA Junior League Golf

Juniors get to be part of a team and compete in matches against others clubs/course around Central Arkansas. A few things to note about PGA JLG...

- Sign up by April 1st.
- Practices will be selected Tuesdays & Saturdays April-July
- Matches will be played June & July (mostly on Saturdays)
- The Schedule of Matches will be out around May 1st
- \$275 - \$75 at online registration and balanced paid through the golf shop
 - Includes: 2 golf shirts, caps, balls, tees, all lessons and matches
