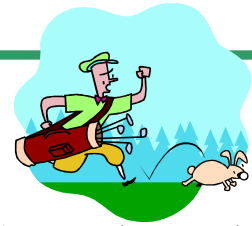
The Mixed Event is scheduled for Sunday, April 15th @ 1:00pm. Sign up by Wednesday, the 11th!

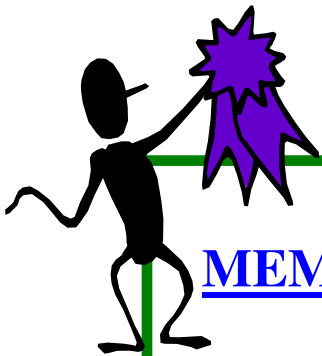

Golf Course News

Officially spring! Time to get the mowers out and the annual color planted! Also stock up on allergy medicine, it looks like it is going to be a bad year for sinus problems.

On the course we are getting ready for the season. Our spring pre-emerge is being put out, and we have aerified the greens. Our mowers are sharp and we have begun mowing the fairways and tees. The grass is green but not really growing much yet, that will change as the temperatures continue to stay warm. We are finishing patching any bad spots on the greens so we have a clean slate going in to the golfing season.

Our bunker project continues to move along well, only a few holes left! The new sand looks great, but will take a few weeks to firm up.

As of March 31 we will again be “90 degree” with the carts. Please remember not to drive carts close to the greens, tee boxes or over any green side mounds! Also please follow any directional signs or ropes placed on the course, these are there to reduce traffic and protect the playing surface. We will be ²⁶⁴⁴ monitoring the status of the driving range and will make the transition from mats to turf as soon as we feel the tee is ready.
