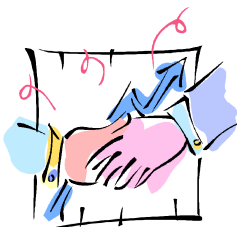

# From the Pro Shop

## Men's Club Championship (September 7<sup>th</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup>) – There will be four divisions in the tournament (Championship, Open, Senior & Super Senior)

**Championship** – 54 holes of stroke play from the Blue Tees (Friday, Saturday & Sunday). All players wishing to compete in the Championship Flight must declare their intent to the Pro Shop. This will be a Gross competition only. Championship Flight will tee off starting at 2:00 pm on Friday and after the Open flights on Saturday and Sunday. Entry fee for the Championship Flight is \$50 per player and payout will be based upon the number of entries.

**Open** – 36 holes of stroke play from the White Tees (Saturday & Sunday). Players will be flighted by handicap. The number of flights will be determined by the total number of entries. There will be a Gross & Net winner + subsequent places 1545 in each flight. Open Flights will tee off after the Senior Flight on Saturday and Sunday. Entry fee for the Open Flights will be \$35 per player and payout will be based upon the number of entries.

**Senior** – 36 holes of stroke play from the White Tees (Saturday & Sunday). Players 55 - 64 are eligible for this flight. There will be a Gross & Net winner + subsequent places in this flight. Senior Flight will tee off after the Super Senior Flight on Saturday and Sunday. Entry fee for the Senior Flight will be \$35 per player and payout will be based upon the number of entries.

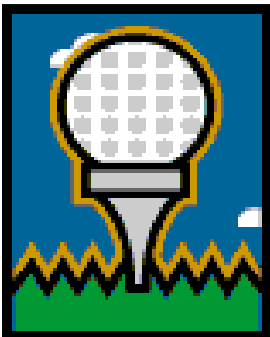
**Super Senior** – 36 holes of stroke play from the Green Tees (Saturday & Sunday). Only players 65 & older are eligible for this flight. There will be a Gross & Net winner + subsequent places in this flight. Super Senior Flight will tee off beginning at 9:00 am on Saturday and Sunday. Entry fee for the Super Senior Flight will be \$35 per player and payout will be based upon the number of entries.

**ALL** entries must be received by 5:00 p.m., Sunday, September 2<sup>nd</sup> –NO EXCEPTIONS.

When signing up, please inform the Pro Shop as to which division you will be playing in. Just a reminder...the Club Championship will serve as the qualifier for the 2007 Mayor's Cup, scheduled for October 27<sup>th</sup> & 28<sup>th</sup>. Play will be open to non-participants 15 minutes after the last tournament group has teed off.

The 2007 "Swingaroo" Member-Guest invitations will be sent out in the next few days. Don't hesitate to sign up for this event. This year's tournament promises to be a great time for all involved. The dates are October 5<sup>th</sup>- October 7<sup>th</sup>. Get that friend or potential member and come play.

## Golf Course Update

Well the dog days of summer caught up with us this year. I hope the intense heat is behind us and cool fall weather comes quickly! As everyone knows our greens did not handle the extreme temperatures very well. During the stretch between July 27<sup>th</sup> and August 27<sup>th</sup> we had only seven days under 100, and each of those days reached at least 97 degrees. Bent grass struggles during that kind of heat pressure.

So now that fall is approaching, we 2018 are working feverishly to help the turf recover as quickly as possible. On the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month we will begin aerifying the greens. During this process we will inter-seed, top-dress heavily and fertilize the turf. With the help of the cooler September temperatures the greens should recover nicely. However, it will take some time. My crew and I ask for the members continued patience with our recovery efforts.
