Golf Course Update

Fall is here! Now that the days are cooler the bentgrass is thriving. Our seed is coming in and the existing turf is growing nicely. We are pushing it with fertilizer every chance we get. This is all great news; however we still need patience. Even healthy thriving bentgrass does not fill in quickly. Over the next several weeks we will be lightly topdressing and rolling the greens in order to create a better playing surface with out stressing the turf. You should notice continued improvements every week until the greens are completely healed.

This is also the time of year we apply pre-emerge on the Bermuda. This application will help prevent the cool weather weeds from popping up. If we rotate the chemical used every season weeds are less likely to build a resistance and thus are more easily controlled.

I hope everyone enjoys the great weather!

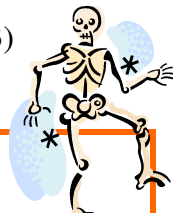
