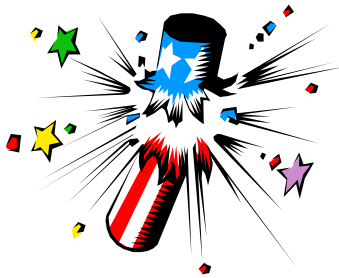

## TURF TALK

As July rolls around, so far, it's been a great summer for golf. The course overall is in great condition, and the greens are only getting better. Our focus has been growing the bare and thin spots back in and to provide a healthy stand of turf. Unlike last year, we are being less aggressive on the greens and taking "baby steps" so to speak on getting them ready for the 2018 Classic. I would like to remind or reiterate to everyone, that we are not planning on scalping or shaving the greens for just the classic weekend, then letting them go. The past year and a half has been a learning lesson, and we are applying what we learned from last year. As opposed to dropping the height and reducing water, and aggressive verti-cutting, this year we are growing a healthy stand of turf, slowly dropping the height, but more importantly, performing a more frequent less aggressive verti-cut and more frequent and lighter topdressing. The greens are night and day from last year, and the past two weeks have been reading a 10 on the stump meter. It is our goal to grow a healthy putting surface all the way to December, to provide the quality surface without near as much stress. We want the quality the membership deserves, and we are definitely on the right track.

If you haven't been down to the driving range, you should check out the new Turfhound mats. They are as close to hitting off natural turf as you will find. Thank you, Pro for pushing to get them, and thank you all to who contributed. We hope to utilize them during our outside events and outings, so to reduce damage to the natural tee, so you the members will get the most out of both.

Lastly, I would like to thank, and hope everyone takes the time to thank the MWGA for the mulch at the clubhouse. In particular, a huge thanks and recognition goes out to Mrs. Sandra Waterson and Mrs. Candice Barker. These two women have worked countless hours on your front clubhouse landscaping. I know it spoils our maintenance crew and the club should feel great gratitude towards their efforts. The flowers and shrubs always look amazing and I would hope each of you would personally thank them when you see them. Thank you Sandra and Candice for all you do.

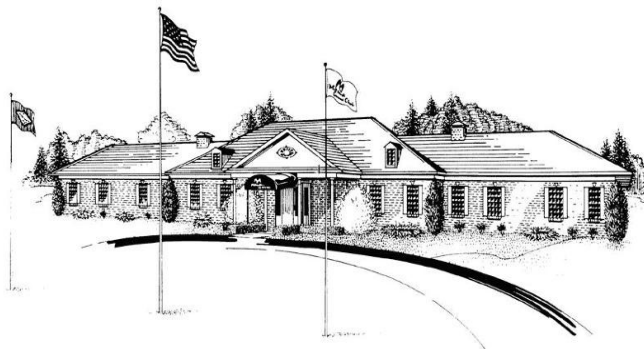
