- 2. Repairing Divots and Ball Markes: Please promptly repair any divots you create on the fairways and ball marks you make on the greens. By taking a moment to repair divots, you help keep our course in pristine condition for the enjoyment of all members.
- 3. Raking Sand Traps: You may have noticed the addition of new sand in some of the bunkers on the front nine. This has really contributed to beautify and the playability of those holes. After playing out of a bunker, please remember to thoroughly rake the sand, leaving it smooth and ready for the next golfer.


Your commitment to these guidelines not only preserves the beauty of our course but also enhances the experience for your fellow members and guests. Thank you for your cooperation in upholding these standards.



### **EMPLOYEE HOLIDAY BONUS**



All members will be billed on their November 30th, 2023 statement for this bonus.


